

Lincoln College – Oxford Australia Clarendon Scholarship

1. The Awards

A Scholarship, funded through the generosity of Australians who have studied at Lincoln College, and in partnership with the Oxford Clarendon Fund, will be available in 2023-2024 for a graduate from Australia to study at Oxford University.

The Lincoln College - Oxford Australia Clarendon Scholarship is open to any discipline and is generally tenable for up to two years, or, in the case of a DPhil degree, for three years.

2. Eligibility

In addition to the usual Clarendon selection criteria, the Lincoln College Oxford Australia Clarendon partnership award will normally be selected on the following additional criteria:

- be an Australian citizen normally resident in Australia
- hold a Bachelor's degree with first class Honours, or its equivalent, from a recognised Australian university
- not have studied overseas for an international degree.

Normally, the scholarship is intended for undergraduate and graduate students, currently studying or working in Australia, to pursue their first international degree.

It is the responsibility of each applicant to ensure that their qualifications meet the requirements of their chosen Oxford University course.

3. Value of the Awards

The Lincoln College Oxford Australia Clarendon Scholarship covers all College and University fees and provides a generous living allowance for the duration of the course.

4. Application Procedure

All graduate applications to Oxford University are automatically considered for a Clarendon Award (www.clarendon.ox.ac.uk) and Oxford University Graduate Admissions will select the awardee for the Lincoln College Oxford Australia Clarendon Scholarship in 2023, based on the above criteria.
