## Ian Wilson-Guy White – Magdalen College Oxford Australia Fund Scholarship

### *1. The Award*

*Available in 2024*

The Scholarship, funded through the generosity of two Australians who have studied at Magdalen College at Oxford University - the late Hon Ian Wilson and the late Dr Guy White - will be available in 2024-2025 for a graduate from Australia to study at Oxford University.

The Ian Wilson-Guy White - Oxford Australia Fund Scholarship is open to any discipline and is generally tenable for one or two years, or, in the case of a D Phil degree, for three years.

### *2. Eligibility*

The Scholarship is open to Australian citizens normally resident in Australia. They should hold a Bachelor's degree with First Class Honours, or its equivalent, from a recognized Australian university.

Normally, the scholarship is intended for undergraduate and graduate students, currently studying or working in Australia, to pursue their first international degree. It is the responsibility of each applicant to ensure that their qualifications meet the requirements of their chosen Oxford University course.

### *3. Value of the Award*

The scholarship provides \$15,000 per annum in the year 2024-25.

The successful candidate may hold other awards with the approval of the Committee. In the case of a scholar winning an additional scholarship to Oxford, the Oxford Australia Scholarship Committee will want to know from the scholar its value and may wish to withhold an amount from the Ian Wilson-Guy White – Oxford Australia award.

### *4. Application Procedure*

i Candidates for an Oxford Australia Scholarship need first to apply to Oxford University by completing the online Graduate Application form at [www.graduate.ox.ac.uk/applyonline](http://www.graduate.ox.ac.uk/applyonline) by the relevant January deadline to start a full time BCL, Master's or DPhil course. The Oxford University online application requires full documentary evidence of relevant academic performance and reports from three referees.

ii All graduate applications to Oxford University are automatically considered for a Clarendon Award ([www.clarendon.ox.ac.uk](http://www.clarendon.ox.ac.uk)).

iii To be considered for the Ian Wilson-Guy White - Oxford Australia Scholarship, applicants, in addition to first applying to Oxford University for a place, need to:

- Apply directly online to the Oxford Australia Scholarship Committee on or after 3 January 2024 at the link on the website which will be provided at that time.
- Be an Australian national, ordinarily resident in Australia and whose academic record is from

a recognised Australian University.

- Provide, as part of your application, full official documentary evidence of your relevant academic performance, three referee reports and a sample of your writing. You also need to provide a supplementary document with your reasons for applying for this course of study and outlining your future career plans and intentions.

#### *5. Closing dates and timelines*

It is the responsibility of each applicant to check for the relevant deadline.

Applications for the Oxford Australia Scholarships open online on 3 January 2024 and close on 16 February 2024.

A shortlist of candidates for the scholarship will be drawn up during March 2024 and interviews, if needed, will be organised by the Oxford Australia Fund Scholarships Committee, to be held in Australia in April/May.
